The proposed project consists of removal and replacement of temporary pavement, concrete drive approaches, concrete sidewalks and ADA ramps throughout the City of Hamtramck. It is anticipated that this contract will be a two year contract terminating after the 2020 construction season. The anticipated start date, weather permitting for the 2019 season is May 6, 2019 and substantially completed by November 15, 2019 and final completion by November 29, 2019. The anticipated start date, weather permitting for the 2020 season is May 4, 2020 and substantially completed by November 15, 2020 and final completion by November 27, 2020.
