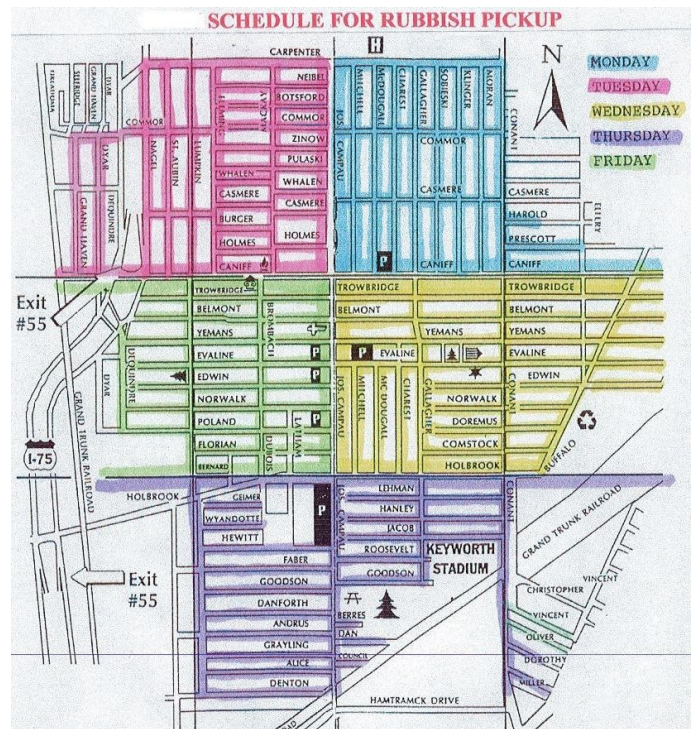
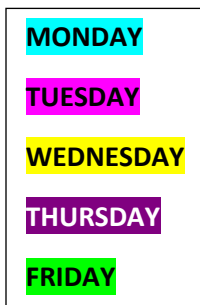
# PRIORITY waste



The City of Hamtramck has chosen Priority Waste as our service provider for citywide waste and recycling services. We have enclosed a magnet with contact information for all your waste and recycling concerns.

### Days of Service

Your residential collection days remain the same. If you are new to the neighborhood and are unsure of your collection day, see this schedule which can also be found on the City of Hamtramck website ([hamtramck.us](http://hamtramck.us)) under the Department of Public Services. Collection services will typically occur between the hours of 7:00am to 9:00pm.

## **Services Provided to Hamtramck Residents**

- **Weekly Household Solid Waste Collection**

All household solid waste must be contained within your 95-gallon cart and arranged so the lid can be tightly closed. Cans should be placed in the alley by 7:00am on the morning of your scheduled collection and taken back into your yard after pick-up is completed.

- **Bulk Waste**

Bulk waste includes, but is not limited to, items such as fixtures and furniture, household appliances, storm doors and windows, toilets, sinks, carpets and pad (cut, rolled, and bundled in 4-ft sections), rail road ties, fence posts and fencing not exceeding 3-ft high by 8-ft in length, small quantities of building debris placed at curb properly tied and bundled in lengths of not more than 5-ft. Priority Waste **will not** pick up junk cars, large car parts, demolition materials, or other materials resulting from large construction and/or renovation projects.

- **Yard Waste**

Residential yard waste collection begins curbside each year on April 1st and continues through November 30th. Approved containers for yard waste are any 32-gallon containers or paper landscape bags. Plastic bags **must not** be used. Yard waste includes: garden waste, leaves, lawn cuttings, shrub and tree trimmings, and pruning waste. Bundled yard waste should not exceed 4-ft in length, 18-inches in diameter, or 60- pounds in weight. Bundles should be tied with heavy twine or rope.

- **Recycling**

Beginning July 1<sup>st</sup>, residents may drop off recyclables (plastic bottles, corrugated cardboard and paper only) 24-hrs a day/7-days a week at the designated recycling site located near 3900 Christopher Street, east of Conant. Recyclables must be separated and placed in appropriate bins. Recyclables should not be bagged when placed in bins.

- **Saturday Bulk Drop-Off**

Residents may drop-off large bulk waste items between the hours of 12:00pm and 3:00pm in the bin located at 3900 Christopher Street, Hamtramck.

Hamtramck residents may purchase new 95-gallon cans from Priority Waste Customer Service at 586- 228-1200. The cans will be delivered at a cost of \$75.00 dollars each.
