The Urban County of Wayne and the Wayne County HOME Consortium have prepared a Five-Year (FY 2021-2025) Consolidated Plan and a FY 2021-2022 Annual Action Plan for the CDBG, HOME and ESG Programs. The Consolidated Plan identifies housing and community development needs, and the Action Plan outlines activities to address the needs identified in the Consolidated Plan. The County also intends to substantially amend the Citizen Participation Plan for these programs to comply with current federal requirements.

Prior to submission to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), drafts of the Consolidated Plan, Annual Action Plan, and Citizen Participation Plan are available for public review and comment from June 29 through July 29, 2021. These draft Plans can be found on the County's Website at <https://www.waynecounty.com/departments/econdev/cdbg.aspx>. The information will also be available for review and comment at the Wayne County Economic Development Department Office, located at 500 Griswold, 28<sup>th</sup> Floor, Detroit, MI 48226 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.

The Wayne County Consortium consists of the Urban County of Wayne, which includes 34 non-entitlement Participating Jurisdictions, plus the Cities of Dearborn, Lincoln Park, Livonia and Taylor.

For FY 2021-2022, Wayne County anticipates receiving an estimated **\$5,689,267.00 in CDBG funds, \$2,838,714.00 in HOME funds, and \$479,825.00 in ESG funds**. HUD Provides these grants for the purpose of assisting low- to moderate-income persons, providing affordable housing opportunities, and/or eliminating blight in Wayne County Participating Jurisdictions and HOME Consortium communities. FY 2021-2022 funds are proposed to be allocated as follows:

**Upgrade the County's Housing Stock** (CDBG \$816,097; HOME \$2,554,843)  
**Enhance Public Infrastructure and Facilities** (CDBG \$540,710)  
**Neighborhood Improvement Activities** (CDBG \$2,634,607)  
**Public Service Activities** (CDBG \$560,000)  
**Homeless Outreach and Prevention** (ESG \$443,839)  
**Affirmatively Further Fair Housing** (CDBG \$22,500)  
**Administration/Planning** (CDBG \$1,115,353; HOME \$283,871; ESG \$35,986)

The proposed allocation of funds is based on estimated amounts and is subject to increase or decrease pending final federal funding allocations, available program income, and prior-year resources.
