## Beautification Commission July 7th, 2022; 6:00PM

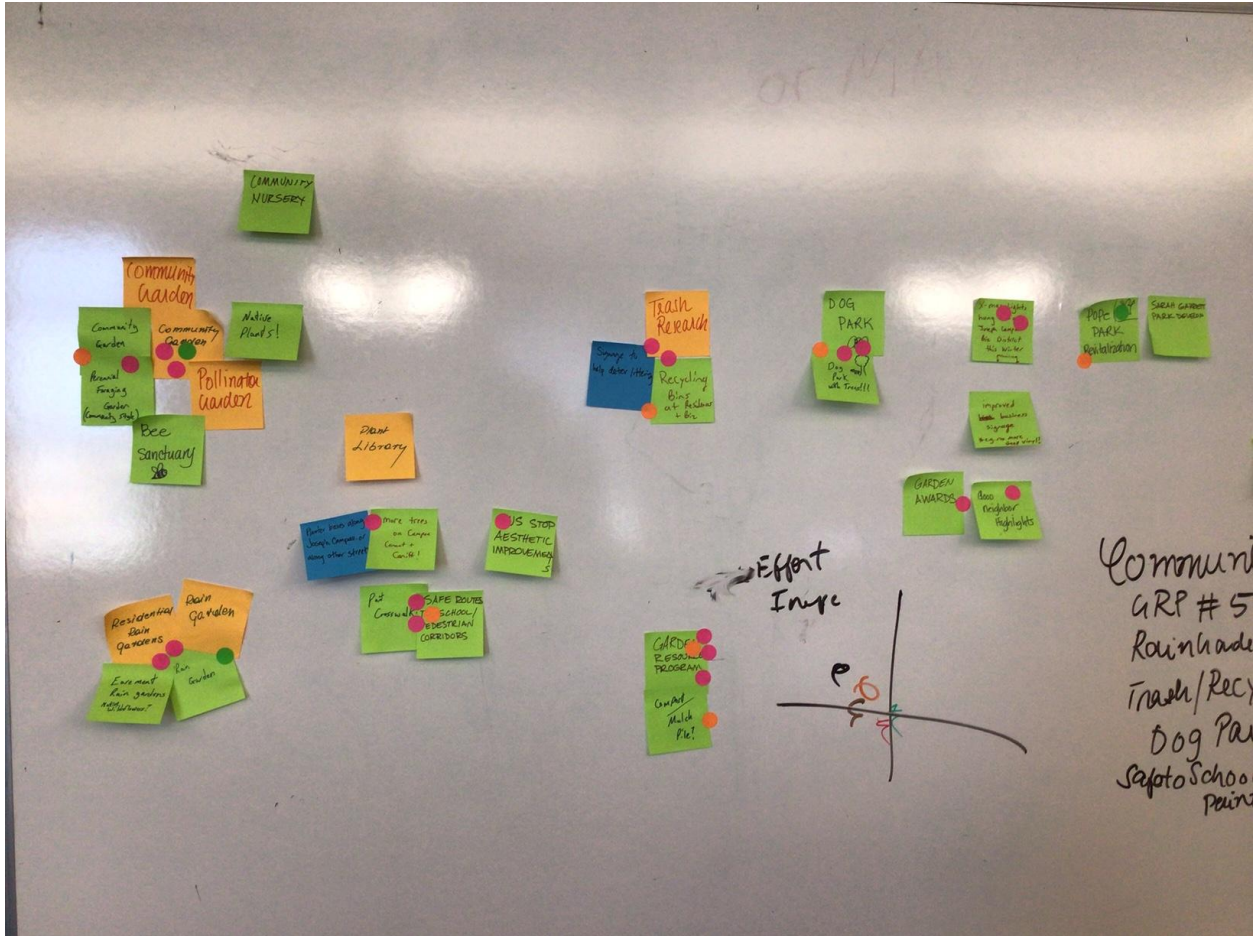
1. Call to order
