  - Saturday September 3 11-1, tea as Zussman Park
    - repeats the first Saturday of each month
    - takes donations
    - sponsored by AAPI PAC
  - Campau Planter Boxes
    - Russ Gordon (Franklin Electric) and Bengal Auto Sales donated a truck (Blasey's Water Wagon) and large water tank to water planter boxes
    - Truck will be unveiled at the Labor Day Parade
    - Doing test run on Saturday to get water from fire department or city hall
    - Looking for volunteers with good driving records to drive the truck especially in July and August
    - Lynn has been collecting plant donations in her yard, but will soon be transporting them into planter boxes
    - Glafira offered her Syhlet plot for more space for donations and for things that don't have room to transplant
    - October 7th, Friday, 10am, partnering with GM who donated 1,250 spring bulbs
    - Meeting at Pope Park
    - Planters will be marked
    - 19 volunteers signed up from GM
  - Hamtramck Area Disaster Recovery Group
    - She has been working with FEMA to form this long term recovery group
    - Interviewing case managers
    - Mission will be to start reaching out to people who made claims with FEMA in the floods the last few years to ensure people have recovered
    - Meets every other Friday at 11 via zoom
    - Has fiduciary, needs help with grant writing and communications
