The spouse, spousal equivalent, child, parent, grandchild, grandparent, brother, sister, half-brother, half-sister, or the spousal equivalent of any of them, whether by marriage, or by blood, or by adoption of the mayor or any councilperson, shall be disqualified for appointment to a board or commission during the term for which the mayor or councilperson is elected.**
